EXPANDED MANDATORY EFILEING IN ERIE COUNTY SUPREME COURT AND NEW OCTOBER TRAINING SESSIONS

Pursuant to an Administrative Order of the Chief Administrative Judge of the Courts, (AO/222/13), the following case types are subject to mandatory E-Filing in Erie County Supreme Court:

- All actions commenced on or after October 1, 2013, except CPLR Article 78 proceedings, Election Law proceedings, in rem tax foreclosures, matrimonial matters, Mental Hygiene Law matters, proceedings under RPTL §730
- All Commercial Division matters, medical, dental and podiatric malpractice cases, tax certiorari cases and asbestos cases commenced on or after July 1, 2013
- All mortgage foreclosure actions involving real property commenced after April 14, 2013.

Mandatory E-Filing is subject to section 202.5 of the Uniform Rules for the New York State Trial Courts. Local protocols on procedures for electronically filed cases are available at:
